

**As a member of the Student Leadership NORTH Class of 2028, I agree to abide by the following standards:**

- Devote time and energy to developing my leadership skills. Recognize that SLNORTH is a highly competitive program and you have been selected to be an enthusiastic and committed participant. Program dates and group mentoring meetings are **requirements of Student Leadership NORTH, and time management is critical.**
- Because it is both an honor and a privilege to be selected for the Student Leadership NORTH program, the highest degree of commitment is expected of all participants. It is understood that you have *chosen* to participate in this program to enrich your knowledge of leadership. The success of the Student Leadership NORTH depends on the **full commitment of each participant** to attend all program sessions, arrive on time, and stay for the entirety of the program.
- Upon acceptance into the Program, each participant is expected to “clear” their personal calendars on SLNORTH Program Day dates. If a participant is unable to attend a session (or part thereof) due to *exceptional circumstances*, the SLNORTH Executive Director/Program Director should be advised by email, text message, or telephone **as soon as the conflict is known**. If an emergency arises **on the day of the session** the SLNORTH Executive Director/Program Director should be advised by email.
- ***Two unexcused absences will result in dismissal from the program.*** Students must inform the Executive Director (Green Team), Irene Sanders, or Program Director (Blue Team), Linda McCain via email or text **prior to the program date** the reason(s) you are unable to attend.
- Engage actively and positively in SLNORTH activities, showing respect for the input, ideas, and creative thinking of class members. ***Active participation is expected of each student in a group project.***
- Communicate actively and in a timely fashion and give candid feedback.
- Adhere to the dress code for scheduled activities and adhere to cell phone guidelines during each session. **Do not wear SLNORTH t-shirt to any political gatherings.**
- Remain alcohol and drug-free and have no discipline infraction(s) throughout the SLNORTH program.
